Peace from the Anglican Church of Korea!

The last Anglican Consultative Council Meeting (ACC-13) adopted a Resolution 40 that Anglican Church leaders in nations with influence on the North East Asia situation consider visiting the Democratic People Republic of Korea and the Republic of Korea and contribute in whatever ways they can to the reunification of the two Koreas.

According to the resolution, the Anglican Church of Korea (ACK) has been preparing a project in the name of the Anglican Communion for the reunification of the Korean peninsula and peace in the region. Throughout the project, we can make the leaders of the Anglican Communion aware of the importance of the reunification of the two Koreas, enhance solidarity in the ACC, establish international peace networking, and develop a movement for sharing humanitarian aid with the North.

The Most Rev. Rowan Williams, Archbishop of Canterbury, offers his full support to this conference. His letter of commendation is enclosed with this invitation.

On behalf of the whole Anglican Church of Korea, we are pleased to invite you to attend the "**Worldwide Anglican Peace Conference, Seoul-2007**" that will be held between 14-21 November 2007 at the Asia Publication Culture and Information Center, Paju (near Seoul), Republic of Korea.

The conference consists of a visit to North Korea from November 14th to 16th and a worldwide Anglican forum for the peace of Northeast Asia from November 17th to 21th.

The conference, organized in the name of the Anglican Communion, will be a valuable opportunity to reflect on the true meaning of peace in the era of conflicts and trauma. It will also explore the role of the church as peacemaker in the Korean peninsula and Northeast Asia.

We cordially invite you to be with us in building up the missionary vision of the Anglican Communion for unification of the Korean peninsula and peace in Northeast Asia.

The conference organizers will be writing to you late in June with full details of the conference schedule and registration. Up to date details are also available on the conference web site to be opened soon.
